The goal of this workshop is to bring together macroeconomists to discuss current research frontiers on a regular basis. To encourage participation from young economists, we aim to reserve 50% of the presentation for economists who have completed their PhD's no more than 6 years ago.

Applications from economists from all Europe-based institutions are welcomed in all fields of macroeconomics. Theoretical and empirical contributions are equally welcome. The keynote speaker will be **Francesco Lippi** (EIEF & University of Sassari).

The workshop is a one-day event which will take place at Banque de France (Paris) on 9 December 2016. A conference dinner is scheduled in the evening of 8 December. Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered.
